Step 1

Step 2


Your dentist will then reshape and prepare your current tooth surface to make room for the veneers.

Step 3

An impression will be taken so your veneers can be made to your exact specification. They will then be sent to a dental laboratory that will make the veneers and send them back to your dentist within the agreed time scales

Step 4

When your veneers are ready your dentist will ask you to come back to have them fitted and you'll walk out of the dental practice a new you.

What are Chameleon Veneers?

They are a thin layer of restorative material which is placed on the surface of your teeth. The most popular material, and the material which Chameleon Veneers are made from, is porcelain as it provides the best natural looking result and the best strength so they can cope with daily wear and tear.

What can Chameleon Veneers do for me?

Chameleon Veneers can improve teeth in a variety of situations, including teeth that are slightly damaged, stained, chipped or crooked.

What kind of preparation is required for Chameleon Veneers?

For Chameleon Veneers you won't need much preparation as it's such a thin layer of porcelain. In fact, in some cases no anaesthetic is required. Your dentist will clean and remove the top layer of enamel so it can be replaced with the porcelain. Of course should you have any questions or concerns please discuss these with your dentist.
